**NO FIREWORKS IN BUCKINGHAM.** In Lake County, "safe and sane" fireworks are ONLY allowed within the City of Lakeport, July 1-4<sup>th</sup>. Fireworks are <u>illegal</u> to possess or use anywhere else, or at any other time, in the county.

**EVACUATION PLAN AVAILABLE.** District 5 Supervisor Jessica Pyska was unable to attend our annual meeting this year, but she did provide us with a few major updates. Thanks to the collaborative efforts of many agencies, we now have a finalized version of the Soda Bay Evacuation Plan. This route is also much safer now due to massive vegetation clearing efforts.
